Facts Outside neutral switch is unable to disconnect the transmission

Offence Breach of Art. 11.3.2 of the LMP2 Technical Regulations

Decision Disqualification
The other cars move up

Reason At post-scrutineering the disconnecting of the transmission was not working as it is written in Art. 11.3.2 of LMP 2 Technical Regulations. The competitor accepted the correct check made by the scrutineers and asked for an additional check with the car battery which was used during the race. After this check the disconnecting was still not working.

The Competitor is reminded of his right of Appeal in accordance with Article 16.1.6. of the WEC Sporting Regulations, Article 13 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
